After the revision of the information concerning the manuscript entitled "Studies on 2(1H)-quinolone derivatives: Synthetic access to pyrano[3,2-c] quinoline and 3-substituted quinoline derivatives" by Abdel-Ghani Ali Elagamey, FathyMuhammadAbdelAziz El-Taweel and Muhammad Hilmy, I recommend the publication of this research. Nevertheless, some typing and grammatical errors are still present in the manuscript. Some of the most common grammatical and typing errors include:

- the use of words as "recrystallised" or "flitration"
- the use of doble space between words
- do not use the correct space between words (Griffin&George)

All these problems are irrelevant and, for this reason, I think that the manuscript should be accepted for publishing in ACSj.
