<p>The revised version of the present manuscript received major updates. The structure of paper is now more consistent with the one expected for a case-report to be published in an international Journal. Very minor language typos are still present nonetheless (e.g. "This study was approval" should be "...approved... ". Therefore, unless the Journal provides a proof-reading service, a further revision for the English consistency should be recommended (most of the typos could easily detected by using the MS Word grammar corrections: e.g. "opoid" ("opioid")...). Finally, I appreciate that the authors emphasized the originality of the report, as recommended. Considering the short length of present contribute (which is a plus), I would recommend considering a final disposition of "acceptance", either a case-report or a letter to the Editor (in this case, please edit the style starting like this..." ...To the Editor..." ...</p>
