Periosteum was replaced?</b></p> <p><b>Figure 1 does not match with the histological description. Observing the images, it seems that Control group presents more bone tissue when compared with Experimental group, at 7 and 15 days. Besides this, the cortical bone tissue, of Control group at 30 days, presents an appearance more mature, compared with same period of Experimental group. Improve the discussion.</b></p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>Lines: 114- endpoint absence between sentences 153- the tibia was broken- is it correct?</p>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>The sentence that begins on line 260 is too long and confusing. I suggest that it be reviewed. I suggest that the authors consider replacing the reference number 11, 15, 22, 24, 49 e 50 for articles in English.</p>
